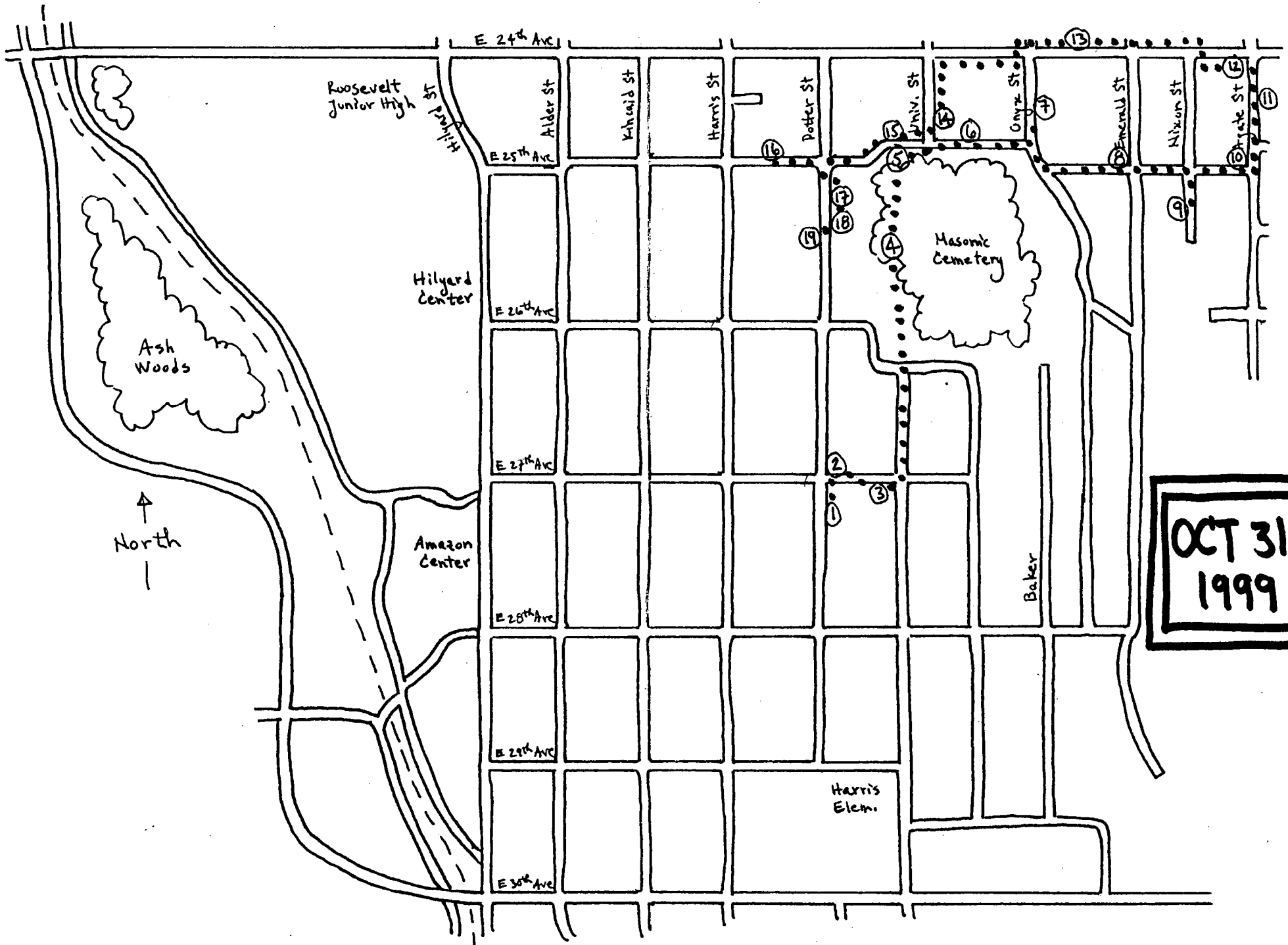


Amazon Neighborhood Walks
